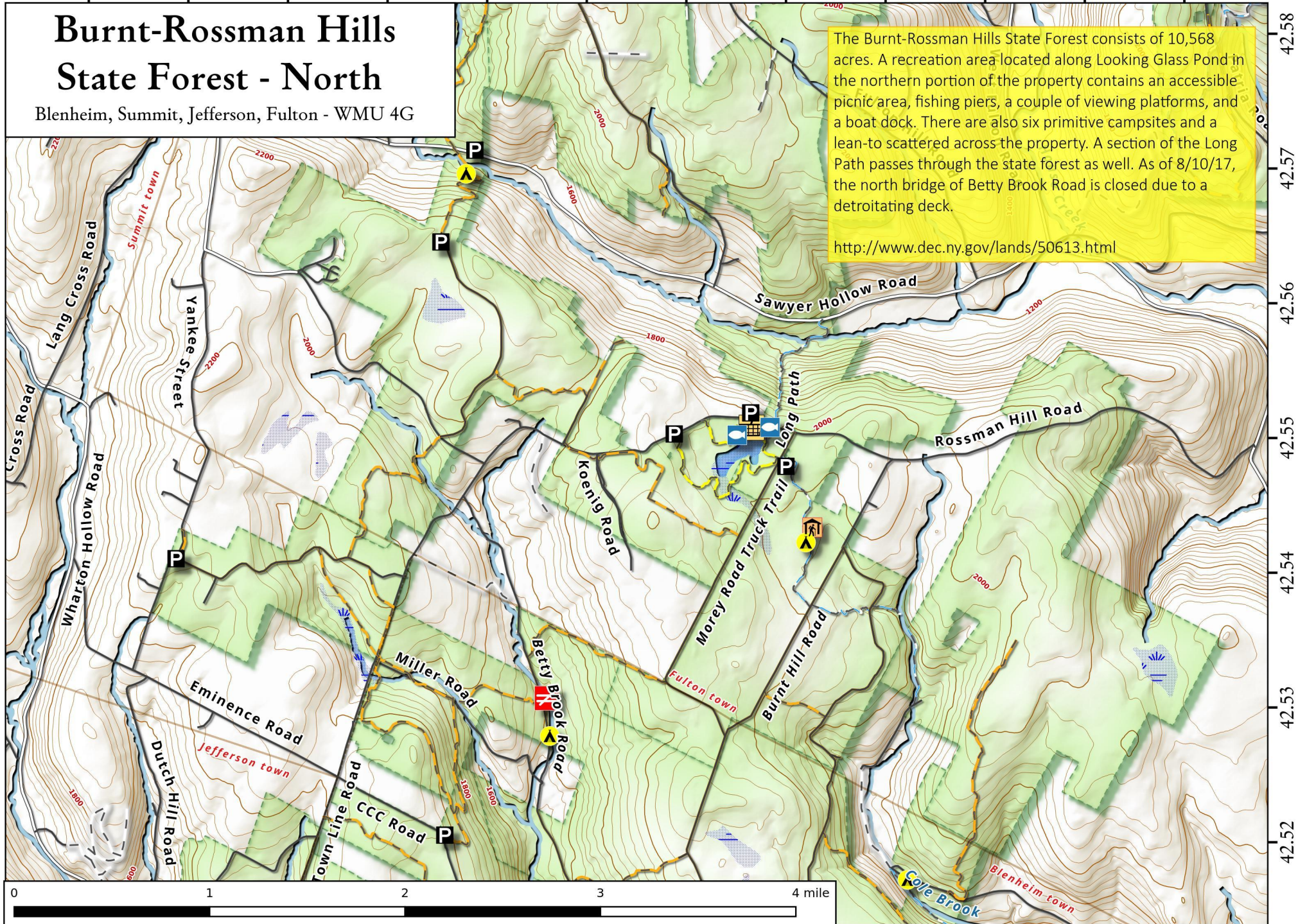


Burnt-Rossman Hills State Forest - North

Blenheim, Summit, Jefferson, Fulton - WMU 4G

The Burnt-Rossman Hills State Forest consists of 10,568 acres. A recreation area located along Looking Glass Pond in the northern portion of the property contains an accessible picnic area, fishing piers, a couple of viewing platforms, and a boat dock. There are also six primitive campsites and a lean-to scattered across the property. A section of the Long Path passes through the state forest as well. As of 8/10/17, the north bridge of Betty Brook Road is closed due to a detroitating deck.
